Special dietary requirements

If you indicated upon registration that you have special dietary requirements, your special refreshments or meals will be arranged for you; please ask a member of the catering or conference staff where to find them.

16. SOCIAL EVENTS

All delegates are invited to attend the Opening Ceremony and Welcome Reception on Thursday, 19 November, from 18:00 to 21:30 in Ministers Amphitheatre. You need to have registered and collected your name tag at the registration desk prior to this as your name tag is you conference identification and ensures access to the event. Canapés and beverages will be served.

On Saturday, 21 November, the Gala Dinner will take place in the Royal Ballroom at the Palais des Congrès de Marrakech. There is an additional cost to purchase a ticket to attend this event for all participants and accompanying persons. Tickets are limited and can be purchased until 17:00 on Friday, 20 November. Please bring your ticket with you to get access to the event. A buffet dinner and beverages will be provided.

17. WEATHER AND DRESS

November temperatures in Marrakech are fairly mild, and it is also the wettest month of the year for Morocco. The average daily temperature during the month of November hovers around 17 degrees Celsius. This average includes a potential low of 11 degrees Celsius, which will occur during the night. There is also a high of up to 23 degrees Celsius.

Casual dress is recommended for pre-conference workshops and conference sessions (be prepared for air conditioned rooms in the Palais des Congrès de Marrakech), casual for the Opening Ceremony and Welcome Reception, and semiformal or traditional dress for the Gala Dinner. Dress for the accompanying person's tours is conservative and casual, with comfortable shoes and sun protection (hat and sunscreen).

18. HOTELS

If you have booked accommodation via the AORTIC 2015 appointed Destination Management Morocco, you will receive a confirmation email. Please check the website <u>here</u> for the contact details and address of your hotel.

19. TRANSPORT

a. Airport Transfers

You are responsible for making your own airport transfer arrangements, and the cost will be for your own account. It is *strongly* recommended that you pre-arrange your airport transfer prior to your arrival in Marrakech in order to guarantee availability. b. Hotel Transport

The official AORTIC 2015 conference hotels are all within walking distance of the Palais des Congrès de Marrakech. Alternatively taxis are widely available and can be used for your own account.

c. Parking

There is no parking in Palais des Congrès de Marrakech. There is limited parking available 'first come, first served' on the street-side nearby the centre.

21. YELLOW FEVER INOCULATION CERTIFICATE

A yellow fever inoculation certificate is required for entry into Morocco if you have travelled from or through a yellow fever zone in the previous 6 days before entry. You cannot get an inoculation upon arrival and your inoculation certificate must be dated at least ten days prior to your arrival in Morocco.

Please contact your local doctor/travel clinic for advice on other recommended inoculations and vaccinations.

22. VISAS AND TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

Every visitor to Morocco must have a valid passport (for at least six months from the time one enters Morocco) and a visa if required (depending on your nationality). Please ensure that you have at least 2 blank facing pages in your passport.

Many visitors to Morocco require a visa in order to enter the country. You cannot apply for a visa upon arrival. If you will require a visa to visit Morocco, be sure to allow plenty of time for the application process before your departure date.

Travel regulations are known to change without notice to the public. We recommend before you travel, to check the current regulations with the Moroccan Embassy in your country. A list of Moroccan Embassies around the world can be found <u>here</u>.

23. INSURANCE AND LIABILITY

The African Organisation for Research and Training in Cancer (AORTIC) reserves the right to cancel the AORTIC 2015 Conference without notice or compensation in the event of any delay, default, failure or cancellation of implementation of any deliverable to or for the AORTIC 2015 Conference which has been caused, directly or indirectly, by any incident of "force majeure". For the purposes hereof, the term "force majeure" shall mean any incident, circumstance or cause which renders delivery of the AORTIC 2015 Conference substantially or totally impossible or impracticable and which is beyond the control of AORTIC. The term shall include but not be limited to the following:

- Any strike, or other industrial action of any kind;
- Fire, flood, or adverse weather conditions;
- Unavoidable breakdown or destruction of facilities or equipment;
- Failure of carriers, delays in performance or delivery by sub-contractors or any other breach by a third party of a material obligation towards AORTIC;
- Power failure;
- Promulgation/amendment/rescission of any relevant legislation or regulation by local or national government;
- Any occurrence of any nature which renders it reasonably necessary for AORTIC to cancel the AORTIC 2015 Conference.

In such circumstances, AORTIC, the AORTIC 2015 Local Organising Committee and the AORTIC 2015 Conference Organisers are hereby indemnified and shall not be liable to any delegate, supplier or other service provider for any loss or damage save that AORTIC shall only be liable to reimburse the relevant party such amounts as may actually have been received by AORTIC, but after deduction of any costs that have been reasonably incurred by it up to the point of cancellation in preparing the conference. This limited liability does not extend to any payments that may have been made directly or indirectly (on behalf of delegates/attendees/service providers, etc.) to third parties such as hotels or airlines.
